Dear Parents,

While we continue to work on the written portion of our Curriculum Fair project, your child may wish to begin thinking about, and planning the visual portion.

The students may need your help in getting some of the materials necessary to put the visual board together. This portion of the project is what will "catch the eye" of the visitors, and make a statement about the paper. Remember this is a student activity- let you child have fun designing and completing this.

The following are the poster guidelines:

1. Poster **MUST** be a tri-fold poster
2. The **TITLE**, (not the topic), should be the largest set of words on the project (sticky letters, stenciling, cut out letters, computer made are all acceptable)
3. Everything on the poster must have a **CAPTION**. The captions must be the following:

HISTORY
ECONOMY
CULTURE
INTERESTING FACTS

4. Students are allowed to get pictures from the internet and other resources. Graphics can be done on the computer and pasted onto the display board
5. Information on the board should be **TYPED**
6. Students may use their notes to help them with the information for the poster

The boards will be due Wednesday, March 30th. Please have your child bring the board to school in a garbage bag. They will take the board home with

them the evening of Curriculum Fair, which is April 4th at 7:00 P.M. There is no food or drinks allowed with the display boards!
