Fifth Grade Expectations

1st Quarter

1. Students will talk about wants and needs in Spanish.
2. Students will recognize and recite classroom words.
3. Students will recognize and use indefinite articles in the singular form.
4. Students will talk about things they like and do not like.
5. Students will recite the Sign of the Cross, the Glory Be, the Hail Mary and the Our Father in Spanish (all year).

2nd Quarter

1. Students will recognize correct usage of plural indefinite nouns and subject pronouns.
2. Students will correctly change singular adjectives and nouns to plural forms.
3. Students will discuss in Spanish the things they need and want for their classes.
4. Students will compare differences and similarities of Christmas celebrations among Latin American countries and the United States.

3rd Quarter

1. Students will describe the items in their rooms.
2. Students will correctly use plural and singular definite articles in oral and written language.
3. Students will make noun and adjective agreement in oral and written language.
4. Students will describe how Spanish-speaking students prepare for the school year, school uniforms, extended family, apartments in Spain, and family life in general

4th Quarter

1. Students will identify and locate countries in Central America (map study).
2. Students will describe Central American cultures.
3. Students will participate in Cinco de Mayo activities.
