



Notre Dame Teacher Endowment Fund

The Teacher Endowment Fund was started in 2001 to provide supplemental pay to our Catholic school teachers at Notre Dame.

The Teacher Endowment Fund allows us to close the gap on the large salary difference between what the Diocese pays teachers and what the public schools pay. Further, we can use the Fund to help retain and attract talented teachers.

Each year the teachers receive a payout from the Fund. In addition, a small portion of the money raised each year is re-invested into the Fund with the ultimate long-term goal of making the Fund self-sustaining.

Funds are raised in two ways:

- 1) Tax-deductible donations can be made at any time during the year to the Notre Dame Teacher Endowment Fund.
- 2) Monies are raised during the year through fund raisers such as:
 - The Manna Program (gift cards)
 - ND3 Raffle
 - Win It and Spend It Raffle
